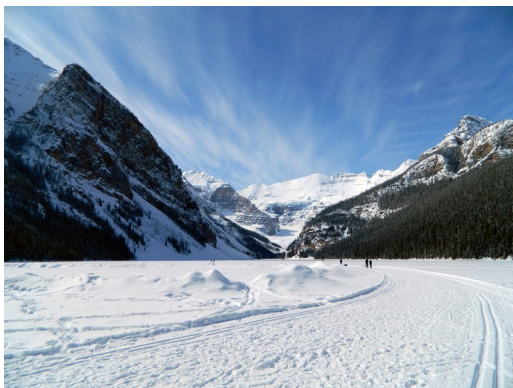

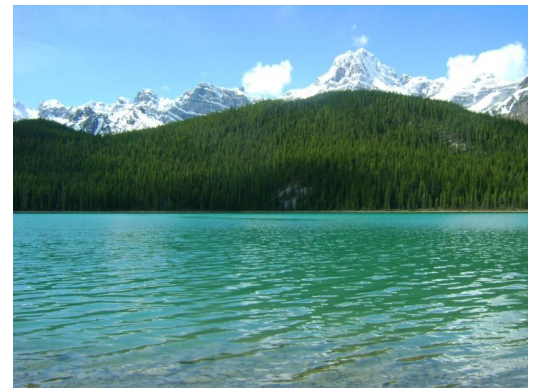

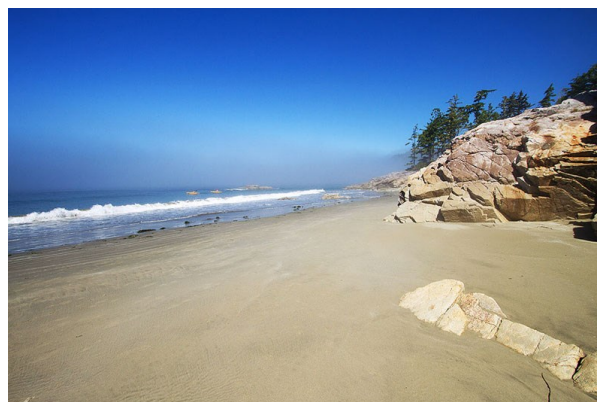

Includes, ferry, lunch, and bike rentals

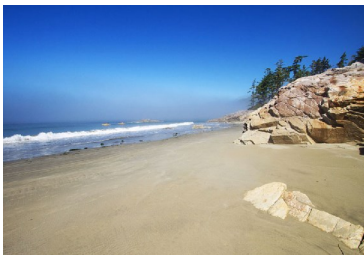


### Grouse Mountain Snow Shoeing, Vancouver

Includes: Ferry, Bus, Gondola Ride, Snowshoes

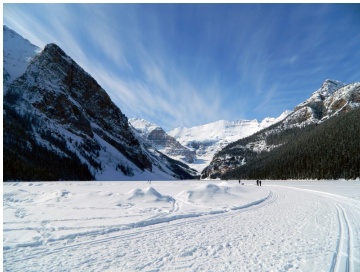


### Tofino Beach Combing, Vancouver Island
